Criteria

- The work must be completed, and the money spent, in this financial year: that is by the end of March 2012.
- Your proposal must demonstrate how it will contribute to you developing skills to work in schools.
- One of the outcomes of receiving a bursary must be the effective delivery of at least one workshop in a school before the end of March 2012.
- Your application should be accompanied by a workshop idea. If you are unconfident in preparing a plan for a schools workshop you may include in your application a request for training to enable you to do this.

Examples of what you might apply for may include a piece of equipment, a training course, an opportunity to shadow a teacher or another artist in a school (where the artist may need to be paid). We are also able to set up opportunities for you to run workshops in schools to enable you to gain experience and skills, if that is what you require.

You may have many other ideas of how you would use a bursary.

You may apply for up to £750. However, there are a limited amount of funds available and we would like to support as many artists as possible. Therefore we anticipate most bursaries will be under £500.
